SUBJECT: Mid-Contract Management Practices for Emergency Forestry

Conservation Reserve Program and State Acres for Wildlife

Enhancement

Conservation Reserve Program participants are required to establish and maintain approved practices according to the conservation plan of operation (CPO). Beginning with signup 26 all CRP participants are required to conduct a mid-contract management practice. Management activities are designed to ensure plant diversity and wildlife benefits, while protecting soil and water resources.

FSA is currently updating the Mid-Contract management activities for Emergency Forestry Conservation Reserve Program (EFCRP) and the Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE) Project Areas. The SAFE Project areas include:

- ➤ Lesser Prairie Chicken Mixed Grass (14 Counties in the Panhandle and South Plains)
- Gulf Coast Prairie(21 Counties along the Gulf Coast)
- Lower Rio Grande Valley Thornscrub (4 Counties in the Rio Grande Valley)

- Management Activity
- > Frequency of Implementation
- > Time Period for Management Action
- > Specification of the Management Activity

A review of the proposed Mid-Contract Management Activity's is requested in accordance with 2-CRP (Rev. 4) paragraph 239B. All recommendations will be provided to the Texas Farm Service Agency State Committee for consideration before approval.
